### **Prism Medical Ltd. (PM:TSX-VEN) Grant of Incentive Options**

Prism Medical Ltd. (“Prism”) (PM:TSX-VEN) announced that it granted options effective July 29, 2009 to acquire 50,000 common shares to a senior officer of Prism Medical UK having a term of three years and an option price of \$6.00. The options vest in three equal instalments on each of the first three anniversary dates of the grant and are otherwise subject to the terms of the company’s stock option plan.

Prism is a provider of durable medical equipment and related services to the mobility disadvantaged in Canada, the U.S. and the United Kingdom.
